

Muhyiddin Receives Visit From Six New Envoys

PUTRAJAYA, Aug 2 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today received a courtesy call from six more newly appointed Malaysian envoys at his office, here.

They included the Foreign Ministry's deputy secretary-general III, Datuk Zainuddin Yahya who has been appointed Malaysia's ambassador to Belgium, and director-general of the Asean-Malaysia National Secretariat, Ahmad Shahizan Abdul Samad who is the country's new ambassador to Bahrain.

The new ambassador to Peru, Ayauf Bachi, previously deputy chief of protocol in the Protocol and Consular Department, and deputy high commissioner/head of chancery at the Malaysian High Commission in Singapore, Dr Ahmad Faisal Muhamad who has been appointed ambassador to Myanmar, also called on Muhyiddin.

Another who called on Muhyiddin were division secretary, Multilateral Economic Cooperation Directorate, Datuk Azmi Mohd Zabidi, who is the new ambassador to Vietnam.

Ambassador designate to China, S. Ganeson, also called on Muhyiddin. He was previously division secretary (Multilateral Politics) in the ministry's Multilateral Affairs Department.

On July 21, seven new/reassigned Malaysian envoys called on the deputy prime minister at his office.
