

Agong Breaks Fast With Cabinet Ministers, Foreign Envoys

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 3 (Bernama) -- Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin and Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Nur Zahirah attended a breaking-of-fast function with Cabinet ministers and foreign envoys at Istana Negara here Wednesday.

Among others present were Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and his wife Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman, and the prime minister's wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor.

Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak was unable to attend as he had a knee operation on Monday and is recuperating.

Also present were former prime ministers Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Tun Abdullah Ahmad Badawi and their wives Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali and Tun Jeanne Abdullah respectively, and Dewan Negara president Tan Sri Abu Zahar Ujang.

Among the Cabinet members present were Information Communication and Culture Minister Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim, Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein, Works Minister Datuk Shaziman Abu Mansor, and International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed.

Some of the countries represented by their envoys at the function were Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Tanzania, Afghanistan, Iraq, Indonesia, Brunei and Jordan.

The breaking of fast was followed by Maghrib, Isyak and Tarawih prayers led by the National Mosque chief imam, Tan Sri Sheikh Ismail Muhammad.
