

PKR, DAP, Pas to decide next week

KUALA LUMPUR: Parti Keadilan Rakyat, DAP and Pas will meet next week to discuss participating in the parliamentary select committee (PSC) on electoral reforms.

Pas vice-president Salahuddin Ayub said they would decide if the loose grouping would be "in or not".

Currently, there is a PSC on corruption, set up last year. In July 2004, a PSC on Criminal Procedure Code and Penal Code was set up. It led to amendments to the two laws.

PKR deputy president Mohamad Azmin Ali said their participation would depend on the PSC's terms of reference and a fairer representation of BN and opposition members.

PKR vice-president Tian Chua said there was a possibility they would opt out from the committee. "Let's see the PSC's terms of reference first." Independent MP Wee Choo Keong said he and other independent members would pick a representative.
