

Chang: BN still has the best service record

IPOH: Gerakan deputy president Datuk Chang Ko Youn said he wondered if Ipoh Timur constituents had elected their member of parliament, Lim Kit Siang, just to make noise in Parliament.

"What has he done for the Ipoh Timur voters? He has not done anything for them although elected for two terms (in 2004 and 2008).

"I want to ask Ipoh Timur voters if they think they have gotten a fair deal choosing Lim as their MP?

"I will say that you did not get a fair deal electing Lim" he said in his welcoming speech at the Perak Gerakan delegates conference here yesterday.

Also present were party president Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon, vice-president Datuk Mah Siew Keong and Gerakan Wanita chief Datuk Tan Lian Hoe.

Chang, who is also Perak Gerakan chairman, said Gerakan and other Barisan Nasional component parties must use every channel and venue to remind the voting public that BN was still the best when it came to service record.

In Perak, he said BN must reinforce its services and convince the people that BN valued service more than the mere talk and lip service practised by opposition parties, especially the DAP.

"Malaysians must not rock the boat built by BN, which has brought the country a progressive, stable and prosperous society.

"A time-tested coalition will ensure stability, certainty and progress.

"A hotchpotch coalition offered by Pakatan Rakyat is a time bomb that will trigger more problems for the country.

"Pakatan is not a viable and promising alternative to BN and voters need to be aware of this fact."
