

Muhyiddin: Call off rally before audience with Agong

ALOR GAJAH, July 5 — The July 9 Bersih rally should be called off before its organisers are granted an audience with the Agong, said Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin.

Speaking last night, he feared Bersih chairman Datuk Ambiga Sreenivasan might misspeak when she gets the audience, according to Bernama Online.

Muhyiddin **(picture)** was addressing a “Kenduri 1 Malaysia” at Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Cina (SJKC) Machap Baru, attended by Melaka Chief Minister Datuk Seri Mohd Ali Rustam, Alor Gajah Member of Parliament Tan Sri Dr Fong Chan Onn and Deputy Home Minister Datuk Wira Abu Seman Yusop.

Earlier reports indicated Ambiga was willing to cancel the city march if when in audience Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin orders her to do so.

The deputy prime minister said illegal rallies harm the peace and harmony multicultural Malaysia enjoys. He underlined that all development projects by the Barisan Nasional were for the benefit of present and future generations.
