

**Government Committed To Combat Corruption Via NKRA - Sabah CM

KOTA KINABALU, Dec 8 (Bernama) -- The government, after having underlined the effort to combat corruption as one of the national key result areas (NKRA), will continue its commitment by updating relevant policies and regulations, as well as strengthening its enforcement jurisdiction and legislation.
