

Dr M warded at IJN for chest infection

KUALA LUMPUR: Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad was admitted to the National Heart Institute about 6am on Wednesday, May 16 for treatment of a chest infection.

Bernama reported the former prime minister had complained of fever and cough for the past two days.

“Dr Mahathir is undergoing treatment with antibiotics,” said his aide Sufi Yusoff in a statement.

Dr Mahathir, 85, who is also president of the Perdana Global peace Foundation, is expected to be in IJN for about a week.

Sufi said doctors had advised Dr Mahathir not to accept any visitors except for his immediate family.
