

Tengku Mahkota Wants Study On Flood Prone Areas

ROMPIN, Dec 13 (Bernama) - The Tengku Mahkota of Pahang, Tengku Abdullah Sultan Ahmad Shah, wants a study to be conducted to address flooding in flood prone areas.

He said this is necessary as certain areas in the state are prone to flooding and this caused suffering to victims and destruction of property.

"We can also build temporary houses on high ground as alternative or preparation for evacuation for people living in the interior," he said after visiting flood victims at Telok Gading community hall relief centre near here today.

Tengku Abdullah said a study including the construction of temporary houses was important to reduce congestion at flood relief centres during the monsoon season.

Up to 2pm, some 480 victims from 114 families were still putting up at four flood relief centres in Rompin district.
