

MACC Forms Special Team To Investigate NFC Issue

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 22 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) has formed a special team headed by MACC investigating director Datuk Mustafar Ali to investigate claims of misappropriation in the National Feedlot Corporation (NFC) issue.

In a statement here Thursday, the MACC said the collection of evidence and testimony had begun since the issue was reported in the Auditor-General's 2010 report.

The MACC also confirmed that it had received the latest report on the case and appropriate action had already been taken on issues raised in the report.

"The Commission is looking seriously into all complaints of corruption and taking stern action without fear or favour," according to the statement.

"All parties are asked to fully cooperate by not politicising the issue to the extent that various speculations had been made that could affect actions taken by the MACC," the statement said.
