

**MACC Raids NFC Office, Seizes Documents And PC**

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 23 (Bernama) -- A number of Putrajaya Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) officers raided the National Feedlot Centre in Solaris Mont Kiara and seized documents and a computer from its office here today.

Eight MACC officers led by operations officer Wan Abd Rahman Wan Mohd Salleh were seen entering the premises about 3 pm Friday afternoon.

They were then seen leaving the office two hours later with a central processing unit and four big white envelopes filled with documents.

Met outside the premises, Wan Abd Rahman was reluctant to provide details and only said NFC had given its full cooperation.

"We only saw a large number of NFC staff and they gave our officers their full cooperation," he said.

Meanwhile, MACC investigation director Datuk Mustafar Ali confirmed the presence of his officers at the NFC office today to obtain evidence related to the case.

"MACC went to NFC's office to seize documents related to the case, to facilitate our investigations," he said.

"Statements from staff and other individuals who are involved will be taken in the near future," he added.

The issue on NFC surfaced following the 2010 Auditor-General's Report in October, which stated that NFC had failed to comply with the objectives of its formation and when opposition parties alleged misappropriation of its funds, particularly in relation to the purchase of a luxury condominium in the city.
