

**Clean Up Perlis For Lima 2011, Says Raja Muda

KANGAR, Dec 3 (Bernama) -- The Raja Muda of Perlis wants Perlis to be cleaned up for the five-day Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace (LIMA) Exhibition 2011 from Dec 6.
