

Promote Culture Of Thinking, Urged Puteri Umno

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 3 (Bernama) -- Efforts to promote a culture of thinking and a healthy debate and not rooted in slanders should be instituted in Umno, said Puteri Umno chief Datuk Rosnah Abdul Rashid Shirlin.

She said the government should set up a talent centre in every community to nurture talents, and an idea bank to store up new innovations to ensure that creative works were promptly patented and prevent them from being copied.

These proposals are aimed at reinforcing the rights and needs of the people, she said when winding up the debate at the Umno General Assembly 2011 here Saturday.

On the next general election, she said the movement, which boasted 365,108 members, would continue to engage young people and capitalise on new media in the party's campaign.

"If we lose this election, it is tantamount to allowing our forefathers' struggle to be stomped, humiliated and entombed by traitors," she said.

Rosnah said Puteri Umno would support winnable candidates chosen by Umno president Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak to ensure the Barisan Nasional's victory at the polls.
