

**Chin, Riot take top two SUPP posts**

KUCHING, Dec 11 — SUPP today announced Datuk Seri Peter Chin as its new president, following a boycott of the party election by challenger Datuk Seri Wong Soon Koh.

Deputy Foreign Minister Datuk Richard Riot was also named as Chin's deputy.

Following the announcement, Chin quickly moved to extend an olive branch towards Wong, saying the latter and his supporters could be accommodated through vacancies in the central working committee.

"I'm happy with the election today and certainly my task after this will be more challenging to rebuild the strength of the SUPP, and I will also go down on the ground to meet with grassroots leaders," the minister of energy, green technology and water was quoted as saying by Bernama Online today.

Chin further said he would approach those in Wong's faction to ensure their continued commitment towards SUPP.

"What is most important is to ensure that the SUPP remains in the [Barisan Nasional] to further strengthen the coalition at the state and national levels," Chin was further quoted in the report.
