

**Working As A Team Key To BN's Success In General Election - Lajim

BEAUFORT, Dec 13 (Bernama) -- Housing and Local Government Deputy Minister Datuk Seri Lajim Ukin said working as a team would be a key to the Barisan Nasional (BN) retaining the people's mandate in the coming general election.

"Like in football, politics too must have people working as a team. If there are two teams (in a party), then there'll be problems," he said.

Lajim, who is also Beaufort BN chairman, was speaking at a leader-meet-the-people function organised by Gerakan at the Rest House, here, last night.

He said there must be team spirit among the leaders and members in BN component parties and not just rhetoric.

"For example, if BN organises a programme, it should be attended by all BN component party members. There should be no overlapping of programmes."

He said with the general election approaching, BN component parties should be helping each other more in getting close to the people and solving their problems so that BN will become stronger," he added.
