

CUEPACS Seeks Meeting With Najib Over SBPA

KANGAR, Dec 15 (Bernama) -- CUEPACS has sought a meeting with Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak on Monday over the Public Service New Remuneration Scheme (SBPA).

Its president, Datuk Omar Osman said the two-day CUEPACS' special meeting attended by 125 delegates in Kuala Perlis, which ended Thursday, unanimously objected the SBPA, citing it as unfair.

He said among others, CUEPACS would raise questions on the proposed salary adjustments of between seven and 13 per cent as CUEPACS was never consulted by the Public Service Department about them.

The deadline to return the SBPA signed offer letters is too short and pressure applied by superiors on civil servants to support the option is seen as unfair, he said when met here.

He said CUEPACS would ensure that the 1.4 million civil servants would get the best deal from the SBPA and urged them not to sign the option before CUEPACS meets the prime minister.

Omar said those who had nothing to do with CUEPACS should not interfere in the matter.
