

Rural Dwellers In Sabah Need To Give Big Mandate To Najib, Says Abdul Rahim Bernama

KUDAT, Dec 19 (Bernama) -- Deputy Transport Minister Datuk Abdul Rahim Bakri has called on the rural dwellers not to waste the opportunity in the 13th general election to give a big mandate to the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and the Barisan Nasional (BN) government for the hard work in developing the rural community particularly in Sabah.
