

**Third Meeting Of Fourth Session Of Parliament Postponed
Bernama
December 1, 2011**

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 1 (Bernama) - The Third Meeting of the Fourth Session of 12th Parliament which sat since Oct 3 was today postponed to a date to be determined later.

Dewan Rakyat passed nine new bills; Kampong Baru Development Corporation Bill 2011, Supply Bill 2012, Public Assembly Bill 2011, 1Malaysia Public Housing (PR1MA) Bill 2011, Medical Device Bill 2011, Medical Device Authority Bill 2011, Liability Partnership 2011, Veteran Bill 2011 and Postal Service Bill 2011.

It also passed the Housing Development (Control and Licensing) (Amendment) Bill 2011, Police (Amendment) Bill 2011, Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment) Bill 2010 (Amendment) Bil 2011, Employment (Amendment) Bill 2011, Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2010, Fisheries Development Board (Amendment) Bill 2011, Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority (Amendment) Bill 2011, Domestic Violence (Amendment) Bill 2011 and Fisheries (Amendment) Bill 2011.

Also passed were the Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment) Bill 2011, Evidence (Amendment) Bill 2011, Finance Bill (No.2) 2011 and Standards Malaysia (Amendment) Bill 2011.

Dewan Rakyat also passed several motions; formation of the Parliamentary Select Committee on Electoral Reform and repeal of three proclamation of Emergency declared in 1966, 1969 and 1977.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak when tabling the motion on Nov 24 said the three proclamations provided under the Federal Constitution were repealed as state of emergency and security threat no longer exists.

In addition, parliament also passed the Restricted Residence (Repeal) Bill 2011 and Banishment Bill (Repeal) 2011.
