KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 2 (Bernama) -- Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein feels that the delegates understood the five core principles conveyed by party president Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, resulting in the matter not being deeply analysed during the debate Friday.

He said the delegates also showed a different attitude this year, including reflecting a higher level of discipline compared to the previous year.

"The way they (delegates) criticised also differed this year because they realised that they will be facing a war (general election)," he told Bernama when visiting the operations room of the Malaysian National News Agency at the Putra World Trade Centre, here.
