

**General Election Disciplinary Committee Proposed By Penang  
Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 2 (Bernama) -- Umno needs to set up a General Election Disciplinary Committee particularly aimed at taking action on members who sabotage the party during the general election.

Penang Umno delegate Datuk Musa Sheikh Fadzir said this was important as victory in the general election was crucial in determining the fate of the party and country.

Umno itself had set up a disciplinary committee during the party election and took action against those found breaching regulations, and similar action should be taken against party members who went against the party during the general election, he said when debating the Presidential policy speech at the Umno General Assembly, here today.

"How to win the general election if we ourselves are not firm in our own party?" asked the Bukit Mertajam Umno division head, who also claimed that no action was taken against those who were found to have acted against the party during the last general election even though there was evidence of such action.

On the winnable candidates, Musa hoped Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak would listen to the people at the division on the candidates they wanted.

"If the particular Umno division does not have a winnable candidate, we agree that a candidate from outside be brought in. A candidate who is polite when entering someone else's territory," he said.

Selangor delegate Datuk Johan Abdul Aziz said Selangor Umno had already carried out self-evaluation and knew how it could win back the state from the opposition pact.

The Semenyih State Assemblyman said: "We in Selangor were deeply saddened over the loss in the last general election, and we envy the states that had won.

"We can no longer lose in Selangor," he said, adding that the feedback received from the grassroots indicated that the people in the state were very happy with the assistance given directly and swiftly by the Federal government.
