

**Najib, Like Former PMs, Lives Up To His Name, Says Umno Debater

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 3 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, like his predecessors, has lived up to his name, said a debater on the last day of the 2011 Umno General Assembly, here Saturday.

Komarudin Omar from Terengganu said just like the names of Malaysia's former prime ministers who had been associated with the various phases of the country's development, the meaning of Najib's name was associated with the transformation he introduced in his administration.

He said Tunku Abdul Rahman had lived up to his name, which means "Servant to the Most Merciful", by helping the people through his eradication of poverty and illiteracy programmes, while Tun Abdul Razak, whose name means "Servant to the Provider of Sustenance" had continued the nation's development with the opening of Felda schemes.

Tun Hussein Onn, who was referred to as the Father of Unity, had also lived up to his name, which means "Good", in fostering unity between the multi-racial and multi-religious people in the country, he said.

He said the development continued during the era of Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who had developed Malaysia as a new modern civilisation and during Tun Abdullah Ahmad Badawi's era through his human capital development.

And now, the country is being led by Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, whose name means "intelligent", who had wisely drawn up plans and strategies to silence the government's critics, especially after Umno was hit by the political tsunami in 2008, he said.

Hence, he said the people should be grateful to have a prime minister who was also wise in introducing various programmes and transformation in sustaining the country's development and reuniting the people, who were probably divided by certain quarters with different political beliefs.
