

**Allowing Anwar's Supporters To Gather Is A Rational Decision, Says Ahmad Zahid

BAGAN DATOH, Jan 6 (Bernama) -- The decision by the Kuala Lumpur police to allow supporters of Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) advisor Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim to gather at a car park outside the Court Complex at Jalan Duta this Monday is a rational move, Defence Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said.

However, he said, they should avoid doing anything against the law.

"They should respect what has been agreed by the police," he told reporters after a meeting with the Village Development and Security Committee in the Bagan Datoh parliament here.

The Kuala Lumpur police have agreed to allow Anwar's supporters to gather peacefully at the car park outside the Jalan Duta Court Complex on Monday when the court is scheduled to deliver the verdict in his sodomy case.

Kuala Lumpur police chief Datuk Mohmad Salleh said the agreement was reached at a meeting with PKR deputy president, Azmin Ali, Friday.
