

**Home Ministry weighs action against Wanita PKR chief**

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 22 — Zuraida Kamaruddin's claim of illegal immigrants being made to swear oaths of loyalty to Barisan Nasional (BN) has caught the eye of the Home Ministry, which is now weighing possible action against the PKR MP.

According to secretary-general Tan Sri Mahmood Adam, the ministry was considering lodging reports with the police and Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) over Zuraida's allegations. He also said the ministry may sue her over the remarks.

"The ministry does not rule out taking all three," Mahmood was quoted by Bernama Online today.

Last week, Wanita PKR said it had proof that illegal immigrants registering with the Home Ministry's 6P amnesty programme have been made to swear an oath that they and their families will vote for BN come polling day.

Zuraida, who is Wanita PKR chief, said illegal immigrants who "respected Malaysia's Constitution" and were worried about their own safety had brought to the party evidence in the form of a written statement requiring them to pledge allegiance to Umno and BN.
