

PKR Wanita chief may be sued over 'Umno oath-taking' accusation

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 23 — The home ministry may act against PKR Wanita chief Zuraida Kamaruddin for accusing the ongoing immigrants registration campaign included "Umno oath-taking" sessions.

The ministry secretary-general Tan Sri Mahmood Adam said they are considering a police report, Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) report, lawsuit or all three. So far they have resisted action, Bernama Online reported.

Last week, Zuraida claimed her party's probe of the 6P programme showed that illegal immigrants were forced to take an oath of allegiance to Umno and the Barisan Nasional as a precondition to registration.

The programme was initiated to register all immigrants — illegal or not — using the bio-metric system with amnesty available to illegals who are then legalised or deported.
