

**Gerakan Ready To Offer Scholarship To Mat Sabu To Study History**

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 10 (Bernama) -- Gerakan says it is ready to offer a scholarship to Pas deputy president Mohamad Sabu to study history at a local university since "he seems to still lack knowledge of the country's past."

Gerakan president Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon said today that Mohamad Sabu could be regarded as a "history illiterate" after his statement that Communist Party of Malaya member Mat Indera was the real hero in the Bukit Kepong tragedy in Johor in 1950 where policemen and their families were killed.

"It is obvious that he is history illiterate. Hence we are ready to offer him a scholarship for him to learn historical facts at a local university from historians such as Prof Dr Khoo Khay Kim," he told reporters at the Gerakan Aidilfitri open house at the party HQ in Cheras here.

Koh said the PAS leader, better known as Mat Sabu, should heed history and not "label" things as he liked.
