

Over 80 Per Cent Puteri Umno Members Registered As Voters

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 15 (Bernama) -- More than 80 per cent of 357,594 Puteri Umno members had registered as voters, Puteri Umno chief Datuk Rosnah Abdul Rashid Shirlin said Thursday.

She said the movement was also given until the end of this month to register the rest of its members as voters.

"We not only want to register these young women as our members, but also as voters. So far, the registration is running well," she told reporters after chairing Puteri Umno executive council meeting here.

The meeting discussed, among others, the preparations of two major events involving Puteri Umno, namely the launch of its mobile clinic programme and an Aidilfitri open house to be hosted jointly by Wanita Umno, Umno Youth and Puteri Umno.

Rosnah said the mobile clinic programme would be launched by on Oct 17 in conjunction with the Selangor Barisan Nasional convention which would be opened by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

"Meanwhile, the Aidilfitri open house will be held on Sept 22 at Putra World Trade Centre from 10am to 3pm. All are invited," she said.

In a separate event today, Puteri Umno also signed a memorandum of understanding to forge a strategic economic cooperation with Woongjin Coway (M) Sdn Bhd.

Rosnah said the cooperation was expected to provide more employment and business opportunities to Puteri Umno members.
