KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 17 (Bernama) - The Prime Minister's wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor said Malaysians are fortunate to live a multi-racial lifestyle in harmony and peace.

They should to be thankful for the country's peace as it enables them to enjoy a better life than people in several foreign countries now facing turmoil and famine.

"Malaysians should be thankful as we have enough food, clothing and is a safe country. Nobody harasses us," she said at Rahmat Ramadan programme at Merdeka Square here Wednesday night.

Also present were Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Shahrizat Jalil and Kuala Lumpur Mayor Tan Sri Ahmad Fuad Ismail.

Rosmah also praised the efficiency of the Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM) in keeping the peace, though often criticised by some.

Rahmat Ramadan programme organised by Women, Family and Community Development Ministry with 25 non-governmental organisations (NGOs), private companies and government agencies, feted about 5,000 target groups.

The target groups include institutions under the Welfare Services Department, the disabled, children, senior citizens, vagrant and poor families.

"Rahmat Ramadan is the ministry's traditional programme since the last six years during Ramadan to fete target groups," said Shahrizat.

She said the programme also aims to promote and develop a caring and sensitive attitude among the public.
