

**Opposition Failed To Stop Felda's Progress - Isa

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 17 (Bernama) - Attempts by the opposition to politicise the role of Felda at the next general election could not prevent it from continue to progress for the betterment of society and the nation.

Felda chairman Tan Sri Mohd Isa Abdul Samad said the opposition had been using the same tactic over the years especially when the general election was getting near.

"They want to erode Felda settlers confidence in the government. That is their only aim as they know that Felda is the stronghold of Barisan Nasional all these years," he told reporters after breaking fast with Felda staff here Thursday night.
