

Sultan Of Pahang Has Recovered From Fever

KUANTAN, Sept 1 (Bernama) -- The Sultan of Pahang, Sultan Ahmad Shah, who was unwell due to a fever, has since recovered.

Tengku Mahkota of Pahang, Tengku Abdullah said his father had a fever during the first day of Aidilfitri and was unable to celebrate it with the people.

He still needs to rest, said Tengku Abdullah today after visiting the victims of a fire that destroyed six houses at Kampung Baru Seberang, Sungai Lembing, near here last Tuesday.

Tengku Abdullah expressed his sympathy to the victims.

Apart from handing over his personal donation, he announced that RM100,000 had been allocated through the Paya Besar parliament constituency fund to rebuild the six houses.

The 5.45pm fire left six families homeless.

The houses were built by a tin mining company more than 50 years ago.
