

**Sabah Can Forward Views Through Other Channels - Musa

KOTA KINABALU, Aug 21 (Bernama) -- Although Sabah might have lost its sole representation in the Malaysia Airlines (MAS) board recently, the chief minister is confident the state government should be able to voice its views at other related committees.

Commenting on the national carrier's move for a collaborative framework with AirAsia and AirAsia X, Datuk Seri Musa Aman believed this was for MAS' own good as it was also timely the company underwent a revamp.

"I think the new directors (appointed in the board) are very professional and those who know about airlines...so, they are putting the right people at the right place.

"This is for MAS' good but whatever it is, Sabah is still represented in certain committees to sit, so whatever problems we have about MAS, about Air Asia, we can voice through such committees," he told reporters after launching the Raya Aidilfitri Shopping with Orphans Programme at a mall here today.
