

Jalur Gemilang distributed under "One House, One Flag" target

KUALA LUMPUR: To rouse the patriotic spirit among Malaysians in conjunction with the Independence anniversary celebration, the Information Communication and Culture Ministry will continue distributing the Jalur Gemilang to the public this month and until Sept 16.

Its deputy minister Datuk Maglin Dennis D'Cruz said on Sunday, Aug 14 the distribution would be made at all levels including government agencies, parliamentary and state constituencies and non-governmental organisations.

"This is part of the government's effort to achieve the target of at least 'one house, one flag' so that Malaysia will be close to every citizen's heart."

He said this after the launching of the new fly Jalur Gemilang campaign logo and blood donation drive of the Kuala Lumpur and Selangor Taxi Drivers Welfare Association at the National Blood Bank, here, today.

Also present was association president M. Manickam.

D'Cruz also called on the younger generation to respond positively to the Jalur Gemilang campaign as the patriotic spirit was seen lacking in them.

"They must show more love for the country so that they will not get involved in negative activities like illegal street demonstrations," he said.

At the event, the deputy minister also received a memorandum from the association which contains several demands related to the welfare of the taxi drivers for consideration by the government and relevant agencies. - Bernama
