

**BN Confident Of Winning Back Seats In Federal Territory

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 1 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) is confident of wresting back six Federal Territory parliamentary seats from the opposition, in the coming 13th general election.

Federal Territory Umno deputy chairman Datuk Raja Nong Chik Raja Zainal Abidin said the confidence was based on increasing support from the voters.

He said that BN had made early preparation and went down to the grassroots to solve the people's problems.

"We always work for the good of people and have never tried to ruin any party. They (opposition) only know how to find fault, do not give any suggestion to help the people and criticise our programmes," said Raja Nong Chik, who is also federal territory and urban well-being minister.

He was speaking to reporters after launching the Jinjang Focus Action Programme here Saturday.

In the last general election, BN was only able to retain the Setiawangsa, Putrajaya and Labuan seats but lost the Batu, Titiwangsa, Bandar Tun Tazak, Lembah Pantai, Wangsa Maju, Segambut seats to the opposition.

The other four seats in the Federal Territory, namely Cheras, Kepong, Seputeh and Bukit Bintang are DAP strongholds.
