

**MCA Youth Proposes Five Motions To Enhance People's Well-Being**

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 1 (Bernama) -- The MCA Youth today proposed five motions to enhance the country's development and the people's well-being.

Its leader, Datuk Dr Wee Ka Siong, said the first motion was for the ministry and government agencies to take wise measures, and explore more income revenue sources, as well as to manage the country's finance and resources effectively, especially the management of government-linked companies (GLCs).

"The GLCs should not only give priority to domestic markets, but to venture into international markets.

"They should also not compete with small and medium entrepreneurs or local business," he said in his policy address at the MCA Youth 47th annual assembly here.

The second motion, he said, was for the country not to simply emulate other countries, but to explore on its own in determining the direction of the country's development.

Dr Wee, who is Deputy Education Minister, said the third motion was for the government to assist youths to venture into business and to encourage them to be involved in research and to produce new innovations.

"The government should provide financial assistance to encourage youths who are creative to translate their imagination into something productive," he added.

He said more employment opportunities should also be created for graduates and the unemployed.

The MCA Youth also proposed that the government used profits made Petronas to help the medium and low income earners, he added.

He said the other motion was for the government to build more houses costing between RM150,000 and RM200,000 under the My First House scheme.

"They should be built at strategic locations, like near the MY Rapid Transit (MRT) stations under the Greater Kuala Lumpur plan," he added.
