

KITA To Hold Roadshow To Gather Support For PM's Move To Do Away With ISA, Emergency Proclamations

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 22 (Bernama) -- Parti Kesejahteraan Insan Tanah Air (KITA) will be holding a roadshow throughout the country to gather support for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's initiative to do away with the Internal Security Act and emergency proclamations, according to a statement by the party today.

The party said Najib's announcement to abolish the ISA, the Emergency Ordinance, Banishment and Restricted Residence acts and amendments to the Printing Presses and Publications Act were bold steps.

"It is very important that Malaysians at all levels understand what these changes entail, Otherwise, they can get confused by groups who are opposed to these changes.

"The Prime Minister's efforts must be supported by all Malaysians irrespective of their political leanings because the changes are of huge benefit to the people," Kita said in the statement.

In the first phase of the roadshow, the party will hold its talks on the changes in Pasir Putih (Sept 27), Kota Bharu (Sept 28), Jerantut (Oct 2), Petaling Jaya (Oct 4), Kapar (Oct 6), Bangi, Selangor (Oct 9), Seri Andalas (Oct 14), Kota Kinabalu (Oct 17), Sungai Petani (Oct 20) and Kelana Jaya (Oct 26).

"The schedule for other areas will be announced later," the statement added.
