

Lim Guan Eng Is Immoral And Unethical, Says JB BN Youth Chief

JOHOR BA HARU, Sept 23 (Bernama) -- Penang Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng's smear campaign against Johor overseas is immoral and unethical, said Johor Baharu Barisan Nasional Youth chief Khalid Mohamad.

In condemning and refuting Lim's statement, Khalid said the reality is that Johor is safe for foreign and local investors.

"We (Johor Baharu BN Youth) wish to invite Lim Guan Eng to visit Johor and see whether he is abducted or not while here.

"The situation in Johor is safe for anyone," he told a press conference together with Johor Baharu BN Youth leaders here today.

Khalid who is also Johor Baharu Umno Youth division chief said Lim should apologise to the Johor people for smearing the state's good image.

He urged the Penang chief minister not to make Johor a "black sheep" in the opposition's political gambit.

He was commenting remarks by International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed in newspapers today that Lim had smeared Johor while overseas.

According to Mustapa, Lim said those visiting Johor risked being abducted, unlike Penang which he claimed to be the safest state in Malaysia.

Khalid said investors had invested hundreds of billion of dollars and that nothing bad had happened to them.

"Investors confidence in Johor as a safe investment destination is proof that what Lim said is untrue," he added.
