

Perak MB Urges BN MPs To Take Heed Of Constituents' Problems

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 27 (Bernama) -- Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir today urged the state's Barisan Nasional (BN) Members of Parliament to constantly visit their constituents and take heed of their problems in order to maintain their trust in the BN government.

Speaking to reporters after appearing on BernamaTV's "Hello Malaysia" programme at Wisma Bernama here, he said going down to the grassroots was the best way to connect directly with the people.

He also said the state government was getting more positive feedback as the people were increasingly comfortable with the state's administration.

He said the BN election machinery was prepared to face the next general election and defend its position in Perak.
