

MCA Youth Unhappy Over Notice Issued To Chinese School In Kelantan

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 30 (Bernama) -- MCA Youth expressed dissatisfaction today over the action of the Pasir Puteh Land office in Kelantan to issue a notice to Sekolah Kebangsaan Kai Chih for organising a Tanglung festival on Sept 15.

MCA Youth chief Datuk Dr Wee Ka Siong said the notice had stated that the school had held an entertainment activity without a license.

"Since when has the Tanglung festival become an entertainment activity? Is this the PAS way of being sensitive to Chinese culture and beliefs?" he said to reporters after chairing an MCA Youth central committee meeting here.

Wee, who is Deputy Minister of Education, said the festival is a cultural activity which should be respected.

The notice stated that action could be taken against the school under the Entertainment and Control of Entertainment Outlets Enactment 1998.
