

**Parliamentary Select Committee On Electoral Reform Plays Crucial Role**

KOTA KINABALU, Oct 3 (Bernama) -- Parti Bersatu Sabah (PBS) vice-president Datuk Radin Malleh said the Parliamentary Select Committee on Electoral Reform would play a crucial part in regaining public confidence in the country's election process.

He said the electoral process in the country needed to be strengthened and supported Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Datuk Seri Dr Maximus Ongkili's appointment as committee chairman.

"He (Ongkili) has the qualification and experience based on the number of elections he has participated since 1994.

"However, he must have the support or assistance from all members or quarters, particularly the relevant authorities," he told Bernama here Monday.

Radin said the election conduct and process should be transformed to ensure no double voting.

"Most of all, the electoral rolls should be cleaned up," he said.
