

**Budget 2012: No More Outpatient Registration Fee For Senior Citizens**

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 7 (Bernama) -- All Malaysian citizens aged 60 and above will no longer have to pay the outpatient registration fee at all government hospitals and health clinics from Jan 1, 2012.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak when tabling the 2012 Budget, said the fee would also be exempted when senior citizens seek treatment at the 1Malaysia clinics and government dental clinics.

He said the government had never neglected the welfare of senior citizens, especially in obtaining services like health and transport.

"They will also be entitled to a 50 per cent discount on LRT and Monorail fares," he announced.
