

**Kelantan Government's Move To Set Up Technical Committee On Hudud Law
"Adamant" - Liow

SHAH ALAM, Oct 8 (Bernama) -- MCA deputy president Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai has described as "adamant", the PAS-led Kelantan Government's move to set up a special technical committee pertaining to the implementation of Hudud law in the state.

He said the move clearly showed that PAS still insisted on implementing the law although there were many objections by various quarters before this.

"The PAS intention to push for Hudud law did not take the views of many Malaysians in the country. MCA has expressed objection to it as it is not relevant in a plural society like ours," he told reporters after officiating a healthy eating promotion programme at the Giant hypermarket near here today.

Kelantan Menteri Besar Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat had said yesterday that the state government would set up a special technical committee pertaining to the implementation of Hudud law in the state.

The PAS spiritual leader said the committee was necessary as the matter involved technical problems although Syariah law encompassing Hudud, was approved by the state government previously.

Liow, who is also health minister, also demanded that the DAP state its stand on the implementation of Hudud law although it was said to have been against its implementation.

He said the DAP should sever ties with its other members in Pakatan -- PAS and Parti Keadilan Rakyat -- if it was not in favour of the Hudud law.
