

**RM100 Million Allocation For SJKT Schools Will Benefit Students - Subramaniam

MELAKA, Oct 8 (Bernama) -- The RM100 million allocation for National-type Tamil schools (SJKT) provided for in the 2012 Budget will be used for construction, improvement and maintenance of schools will benefit students, Human Resource Minister Datuk Seri Dr S. Subramaniam said.

He said the allocation would be used for repair of school buildings, building of additional blocks and purchase of equipment.

"The allocation will facilitate construction and development of about 30 SJKT schools," he told reporters after receiving the Darjah Gemilang Seri Melaka (DGSM) in conjunction with the 73rd birthday of Melaka Yang Dipertua Negeri Tun Mohd Khalil Yaakob today.

He said this when asked to comment on the 2012 Budget tabled by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak in Parliament yesterday.

Subramaniam said a RM50 million allocation was also made for improvement of water supply facilities in estates.

He said between 40 and 50 estates would benefit from the allocation.
