

**Don't Be Hoodwinked By Opposition - Muhyiddin

SEREMBAN, Oct 15 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin reminded the people today to be grateful for the efforts of the government to improve their lots and not to be hoodwinked by the promise made by the opposition.

He said the government always cared for the people and had drawn up numerous programmes for their benefit.

"It's not easy to be the government; the opposition is only good at making promises which they never have to fulfil," he told about 10,000 people here after visiting the Ampangan market and surrounding areas.

He was accompanied by Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan.

Muhyiddin also reminded the people of Ampangan not to make the same mistake made by the those who voted for the opposition in Selangor and several states in the last election.

At the event, Muhyiddin announced an allocation of RM5 million to refurbish the Ampangan market and provide assistance to the people in the area.

Of the amount, RM4 million will be for the construction of a new hawker's centre, RM500,000 to refurbish the Ampangan market and the rest, to repair and repaint the Ampangan flat.
