

**Opposition Expert Spinmeisters, Says Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 16 (Bernama) -- The Opposition are expert spinmeisters who like to manipulate issues to their own benefit, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

Taking a jibe at the opposition when addressing the delegates attending Gerakan's 40th National Delegates Conference (NDC) at Menara PGRM here today, he said the opposition liked to blame the government for almost anything including those it did not commit, for instance accusing the government of rigging the electoral system.

"They like to say the Barisan Nasional (BN) manipulates the polls. Why did they not question the DAP's winning in Penang.

"If we want to manipulate the polls, do you think we will let them take Penang, or Selangor?"

His remarks received a "no way" unison response from the delegates but in jest Najib replied saying "I'll do it my way".

Najib, who is also BN chairman, said he would prove to the people that Malaysia under the BN government was a government that delivered and "walked the talk".

"We have to prove that when we talk about transformation, we are better than "reformasi" (reformation)," he said in taking another dig at the opposition's "reformasi" clarion call.

Najib said he was also committed to realising all transformation programmes to make Malaysia a high income country.

He said the people were also beginning to see the fruits of these transformation programmes.

"I believe the BN now is getting better support from the people than before. The people are beginning to see the changes being brought about.

"As your leader, I will deliver what the people of Malaysia want," he said.

At a press conference later, when asked about the opposition's claim that the two proposed new acts to replace the Internal Security Act would be "old wine in new bottles", Najib said:

"Wait, we will prove them wrong."

The proposed new acts are to counter terrorism and safeguard national security.
