

**Najib Hopes Noramfaizul's Sacrifice Can Inspire Media Practitioners**

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 19 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak hopes Bernama TV cameraman Noramfaizul Mohd Nor's sacrifices in Somalia would become an inspiration to all media practitioners.

Najib said all media practitioners need to consider the tragic incident as an example to become an inspiration to continue their struggle with added determination to glorify the profession of journalism.

"This incident was like 'bite the hands that feed' (referring to the African Union that allegedly fired a shot that killed Noramfaizul)," he said in his speech during the Premier Media Night 2011 at Dewan Perdana Felda, Tuesday night.

Najib said this morning, Somalia Deputy Prime Minister Mohamed Mohammad H.Ibrahim had met him personally to offer his sympathy for the incident.

During the media night, Najib also handed a RM425,933.04 cheque from the insurance company to the father of Noramfaizul, Mohd Nor Mat Yasin, 66.

The Prime Minister also handed a personal contribution of RM11,000 to TV3 cameraman Aji Saregar Mazlan who was injured during the mission for his wedding on Nov 11, while all 54 volunteers from the media who went to Somalia during the Humanitarian aid mission received certificates of appreciation.

To appreciate his sacrifice, Noramfaizul who was killed by a stray bullet in Somalia had also received the Bintang Gagah Perkasa (BGP) from Melaka.
