

Committee To Meet Jais, Organisers Of Function At DUMC, Tomorrow

SHAH ALAM, Aug 24 (Bernama) -- The Hearing Committee formed by the Selangor government to look into the Selangor Islamic Religious Department's (Jais) inspection of the Damansara Utama Methodist Church (DUMC), will hold a meeting with Jais and the organisers of the thanksgiving function at the church when Jais enforcers came, tomorrow.

Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim said the committee, made up of himself, Selangor mufti Datuk Mohd Tamyas Abdul Wahid and Mohd Tamyas' deputy Datuk Abdul Majid Omar, would meet the two groups at 2pm at the Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah building here.

"We will be meeting them separately for about an hour each," he told the media after chairing the weekly state executive council meeting here.

He said after completing hearing from both sides, the committee would report its findings to Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah of Selangor.

Jais had carried out the inspection at DUMC on Aug 3 after receiving complaints that proselytisation activities were taking place there.

However, the organisers known as Komuniti Harapan had claimed that they were merely hosting a thanksgiving function at the venue.
