

**Najib To Go On Walkabout In Lebu Ampang On Oct 22**

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 26 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will go on a walkabout in Lebu Ampang and surrounding areas on Oct 22, in conjunction with the Deepavali celebration, according to Deputy Federal Territories and Urban Wellbeing Minister Datuk M. Saravanan.

He said the walkabout, which is scheduled to begin at 4pm, would offer an opportunity for over 10,000 Indian traders and hawkers in the area to get up close and personal with the prime minister.

"The prime minister will also try the 'maruku' and other Indian traditional delicacies sold in the area," Saravanan told a press conference here Monday.

Saravanan said the walkabout was expected to bring back fond memories for the prime minister as the area was where his alma mater, Sekolah Kebangsaan St John 1, was located.

Just like Brickfields, which is known as 'Little India', Lebu Ampang is also a vibrant area, with predominantly Indian boutiques, shops and restaurants.
