

**Noh Challenges Selangor MB To Name Assemblymen Who Receive Incentive

PHNOM PENH, Oct 15 (Bernama) -- Selangor Umno deputy chairman Datuk Seri Noh Omar has challenged the Selangor Menteri Besar to list the names of Selangor State Assemblymen who are alleged to have received incentives for being diligent which was passed by the State Assembly sitting in March.

He said he had raised the issue because of the hypocrisy of the opposition in rejecting the proposal for an increase in the allowance of members of Parliament in the 2012 Budget whereas the Selangor Assemblymen had already received the RM2,000 increase which was backdated to January this year.

Noh, who is also the Member of Parliament for Tanjung Karang, said when the matter on the increased allowance for Selangor Assemblymen was raised, Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim had denied that the payment was an allowance, saying that it was an incentive for diligent Assemblymen who visited their constituencies at least five times a month.

Noh, who is the Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Minister, said this at a media conference after witnessing the signing of the agreement of understanding on reciprocal investment between the Malaysian company, Markmore Group and Paragon Corporation, here Saturday.
