

Wanita MCA Okays Resolution On More Women Electoral Candidates

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 1 (Bernama) -- Wanita MCA has adopted a resolution, calling on the party leadership to nominate more women candidates for the next general election.

This was among the six-point resolution that was passed by the movement at the end of its 36th annual general meeting held at Wisma MCA here today.

The movement also rejected the implementation of hudud laws, urging the government to uphold the fundamental rights of its citizens as enshrined in the federal constitution.

Another resolution called on the government to gather extensive public opinion before implementing new policies to ensure that they would benefit the nation.

The delegates were also in favour of according non-citizen spouses, irrespective of gender and nationality, and their children, the right to permanent residency and citizenship.

Other resolutions adopted by Wanita MCA included the need for the government to comprehensively review initiatives on encouraging the return of Malaysian experts currently overseas, with a view to obtain optimum results.

The MCA wing also wanted the government to ensure a fair and transparent mechanism in the selection and distribution of Public Service Department's local and overseas scholarships.
