

Sabah BN Leaders Told To Avoid Misunderstandings

TAWAU, Oct 22 (Bernama) -- Sabah Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman has reminded leaders of Barisan Nasional (BN) component parties in the state to avoid any misunderstanding to protect the integrity of the coalition.

Musa, who is also state BN chairman, said any differences should be amicably resolved in a family spirit.

"We must continue to work together. Let's not have any quarrels between us," he said at the meet the people gathering attended by several thousands people at Tanjung Batu near here Saturday.

Speaking to reporters later, he said the BN could recapture the Sri Tanjung state seat if BN leaders go down onto the ground, work hard to assist the people and talk less.

Musa asked all state assemblymen to list projects required by the people in their respective constituencies and submit them to district officers or local council presidents for consideration.

He said the "nasi tapau" (rice meals) served at the community gathering enabled the people and leaders to exchange pleasantries, interact and hold discussions.

"BN leaders should continue championing the people in line with the "1Malaysia: People First, Performance Now" concept," he added.
