

**Sabah State Budget For 2012 To Be Tabled On Nov 18**

KOTA KINABALU, Nov 2 (Bernama) -- The Sabah state budget for 2012 is expected to be tabled during the Sabah State Legislative Assembly in Likas near here on Nov 18.

Sabah State Legislative Assembly Speaker Datuk Seri Salleh Said Keruak said debate on the budget would start on Nov 21.

"So far the Dewan has not been informed if there are any bills to be tabled during the assembly...but normally there will be. There will also be resolutions but we have not received any so far," he told reporters after opening the Percetakan Nasional Malaysia Berhad (PNMB) in Taman Perindustrian Kota Kinabalu here today.

As for claims that Sabah Progressive Party (SAPP) will submit an application to enable the proposed Amanah Saham Sabah (SAS) to be brought to the assembly, Salleh said all state assemblymen including those from the government and opposition have the right to submit their resolutions.

"We do not stop SAPP, DAP or backbenchers to submit resolutions according to the standing order. However, as the speaker, I will study them before making any decision," he said.
