

**Parliament: Foreign Minister Will Visit Palestine As Soon As Condition Permitted

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 10 (Bernama) -- Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman would make an official visit to Palestine as soon as the situation there permitted, said his deputy, Datuk Richard Riot Jaem.

Replying to a question from Datuk Kamarudin Jaffar (PAS-Tumpat) at Dewan Rakyat here today, he said the visit, which was scheduled on Oct 16 and 17, was postponed due to the security factor.

"The intention (to visit Palestine) was discussed between Malaysia and Palestine during the 66th session of the United Nations General Assembly, but it had to be cancelled due to unsafe condition," he said.

The deputy minister said all parties should understand that the official visit to Palestine was different from those to other countries due to the presence of the Israeli regime.

He said a person, not only needed to pass the roadblocks but also had to undergo body inspections even though permission to visit was granted.
